

# Example Proportion Based POA Consensus Worksheet 2

*One for each Evaluator*

**Use one sheet per scenario.**

- Evaluators must have access to all available information regarding this search. *(It is advisable to construct at least three possible scenarios.)*
- Consider only one scenario at a time to be true when assigning values. Use one worksheet per scenario.

1. Evaluators can decide and use the values of 100 or 10 as their reference when assessing segment values. This must be done prior to evaluators making their assessments. The values assigned each segment must be proportional to this reference value.
2. Assign an appropriate value to each segment.
  - The proportionality of assigned values is extremely important and must be carefully considered.
  - All segments with the same assigned value have the same likelihood of containing the subject.
  - There is no upper or lower limit to the proportional assessment values that can be assigned to a segment. The values need not add up to any particular number. Whole numbers are sufficiently accurate and should be used.
3. When this form is filled out, give this form to the Plans Function staff member who will tabulate evaluator values on Worksheet #2.
